**Current Situation:** There is minimal fire activity on the Springs Incident. Remaining firefighters continue to construct control lines, mop up operations and patrol the fire perimeter. Due to fire activity there is an increase in demobilization of firefighting resources.

**All evacuations orders have been lifted**

**Evacuation Center:** Malibu High School.

**Road Closures:** Potrero Road is closed between Reino Road and Hidden Valley. Residents may return to their homes with proper identification. Residents are encouraged to access Hidden Valley from West Lake Boulevard.

**Cooperating Agencies:** Ventura County Fire Department, CAL FIRE, USFS, Ventura County Sheriff, National Park Service, California State Parks, CHP, Ventura County Animal Control, CalEMA, Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation, California Conservation Corps, Southern California Edison and Red Cross.
