Current Situation: Little to no fire behavior has been observed, however there are still isolated hot spots in the area requiring extinguishment and continued monitoring. Smoke could be visible for the next several weeks. Demobilization will continue as needed through the remainder of the week.

Evacuations: Hungry Valley State Park and Piru Creek recreation area will remain closed until further notice.

Road Closures: Hungry Valley State Park and Gold Hill Road are scheduled to be reopened on 5/22/2013 during daylight hours. Frazier Mtn. Road will remain closed until 5/24/2013.
