**Current Situation:** Actively working multiple spot wildland fires in Sonoma and Solano Counties. The wildland fires are in remote areas, with difficult access and steep terrain. Largest fire grew to 4 acres in Solano County (100% contained 6-10-13 @ 1459). All roads are currently open.

### Wildfire location by county:

**Sonoma County** - 18 spot fires – 4 fires 100% contained

Areas: Healdsburg - Chalk Hill Road, East of Santa Rosa -Mountain Home Ranch Road, Geyserville/Knights Valley, Sea Ranch, Cazadero - Mohrhardt Ridge Road, Bohemian Grove – Stoetz Lane and Mount Jackson.

**Solano County** – 4 fires – all 100% contained

Areas: North of Vacaville - Cantelow Road, Northeast of Vacaville - Pleasant Valley Road, Northwest of Vacaville - Quail Canyon Road and Pleasant Valley.

**Lake County** – 2 fires – all 100% contained

Areas: North of Upper Lake - Elk Mountain Road, Northeast of Upper Lake - Clover Valley Road.

**Colusa County** – 1 fire – 100% contained

Area: West of Williams - Leesville-Ladoga Road.
