Current Status: No growth as firefighters continued constructing and improving containment lines throughout the day. Increase in acreage is due to more accurate mapping and ground-truthing. Use extreme caution as fire suppression, repair assessment and mitigation continue. Demobilization of fire resources is in progress.

Evacuations: The Pacific Crest, Marion Mountain and Seven Pines hiking trails remain closed. Marion Mountain, Fern Basin, Dark Canyon, Black Mountain and Boulder Basin campgrounds remain closed.

Road Closures: Hwy 243 remains closed between Banning and Poppet Flats.

Cooperating Agencies: Federal, State and Local Agencies from throughout the Western United States.

Animal Evacuations: San Jacinto Valley Animal Campus closed today.
