Current Status: Firefighters closed the containment lines today. Large scale demobilization of incident resources continues. Command of the incident will be turned over to Riverside County effective Tuesday August 8th. Silent Valley RV Club remains closed. For questions regarding the closure, please the Silent Valley RV Club.

Evacuations: The Pacific Crest, Marion Mountain and Seven Pines hiking trails remain closed. Marion Mountain, Fern Basin, Dark Canyon, Black Mountain and Boulder Basin campgrounds remain closed.

Road Closures: Hwy 243 remains closed between Twin Pines Road and Westley Street in Banning due to road damage.

Cooperating Agencies: Federal, State and Local Agencies from throughout the Western United States.
