Current Situation: Firefighters continue to strengthen existing containment lines and mop up hot spots. There will continue to be smoke coming from the interior of the fire for the next several days. All evacuation warnings and orders have been lifted. A Red Flag Warning remains in effect for dry lightning storms that have moved into the area extending into Wednesday evening.
