**Current Situations:** The fire continues to burn in rugged terrain, in a section of the Ishi Wilderness. The fire is threatening the 500 KV powerlines that serve 15 western states. Control efforts continue to be hampered by very limited access for ground resources, as well as winds that increase historically in the afternoon. Fire crews are being flown into parts of the fire that are inaccessible, to cut containment lines around the fire.
