Current Situations: The fire is threatening the 500 KV powerlines that service 15 western states. The fire continues to burn in rugged terrain and in a section of the Ishi Wilderness. Control efforts continue to be hampered by very limited access for ground resources, as well as winds that increase historically in the afternoon. Due to inaccessability, 340 fire personnel were flown into parts of the fire today to cut containment lines around the fire. The DC-10 Air Tankers were utilized on the Deer Fire today.
