CURRENT SITUATION: The fire is projected to grow through the night to the south and west. Transmission and distribution power lines in the area are at continued risk, water infrastructure in the area is at risk. Evacuations continue in the areas below.

A CAL FIRE Type I Incident Management Team has been ordered. Team 5 is scheduled to take command of the fire at 3 p.m. tomorrow.

ROAD CLOSURES:

- Palm Avenue and Olive Street
- Clear Creek Road at Honeybee
- Black Pine Road at Gas Point Road
- Cloverdale Road at Hawthorne Avenue
- Placer Road at Cloverdale Road
- Placer Road at Platina Road

EVACUATIONS: Residents have been advised to evacuate from the following areas:

- Clear Creek Road and Cloverdale Road
- Everything southwest to Gas Point Road and Small Farms and Marsha Way
- Gas Point Road and Happy Valley Road
- Small Farms track south to Black Pine Road
- Cloverdale from Clear Creek to Oak
- Oak to Palm
