**Current Situation:** Firefighters continue to construct control lines and continue mop up operations. Due to more accurate mapping the acreage has been reduced. The Damage Inspection Team continues to assess properties in the affected communities. The evacuation center has been relocated to Igo Community Church (6287 Placer ST. Igo CA).

**Evacuations Orders:** Residents have been advised to evacuate from the following areas:

- Clear Creek Road and Cloverdale Road
- Everything southwest to Gas Point Road and Small Farms and Marsha Way
- Gas Point Road and Happy Valley Road
- Small Farms track south to Black Pine Road
- Cloverdale from Clear Creek to Oak
- Oak to Palm
