## Repopulation Update



Thursday, September 12, 2013, 7:00 a.m.

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### **I. Repopulation Issues**

- Our responsibility is to make area safe
- County Roads is working to make roads safe including guardrails, debris, etc
- Hazard Trees – Need to make all trees safe especially along roadways
- PG&E has approximately 200 power poles to replace concern about downed wires and back feed from generators. PG&E has 30 crews working to restore power and has many roadways blocked. As power is turned on, each residence must be inspected to ensure downed power lines do not present an issue.
- We are doing everything we can to accommodate civilians and get people back into their homes.

### **II. Phase I Cloverdale Estimate 1000, Thursday September 12**

- Open Cloverdale and Clear Creek to residents only
- Residential access on Cloverdale , Dale south remains closed
- Work around origin site with traffic control. This will include any PG&E work that needs to be done
- Maintain hard closer at Clear Creek at Gas Point

### **II. Phase II Lower Gas Point Estimate 1600, Thursday September 12**

- Establish checkpoint to Gas Point and Lower Gas Point on the North
- Maintain Clear Creek at Gas Point
- Move southern Gas Point and Lower Gas Point closure to the north at the fire perimeter
- Opens to residents all of Lower Gas Point

### **III. Phase III Small Farms Estimate 1000, Saturday September 14**

- Residents Only
- Must work with PG&E, possible impacts to roadways as they finish work
- Maintain road closures to residents only in Small Farms
- Lift all other road closures

### **IV. Phase IV Small Farms, Estimate 2000, Saturday September 14**

- Eliminate all road closures
- PG&E to maintain traffic control as needed
