Current Situation: CAL FIRE, Shasta County Sheriff's Office, Shasta Public Works, and PG&E are continuing to working diligently to eliminate hazards within the fire's perimeter to repopulate evacuees. Phase One of the repopulation plan will be implemented at 10:00 AM this morning. Firefighters continue to make great progress on strengthening control lines, and mopping up hot spots around the fire perimeter. Fire Suppression repair and rehabilitation has begun. The Damage Inspection Team will continue to assess damaged properties within the affected communities.
