Current Situation: CAL FIRE, Shasta County Sheriff's Office, Shasta Public Works and PG&E are continuing to work diligently to eliminate hazards within the fire's perimeter to repopulate evacuees. Phase One and Two of the repopulation plan were implemented this afternoon. Firefighters continue to make great progress on strengthening control lines and mopping up hot spots around the fire perimeter. Fire Suppression repair and rehabilitation has begun. The Damage Inspection Team will continue to assess damaged properties within the affected communities.
