Friday November 22, 2013 @ 1645

Acreage: 300 acres

Containment: 50%

Location: Northeast of Napa – Loma Vista Area

Weather: Mid- 70's, 14 % humidity, winds to 8 mph with gust to 20 to 30 mph.

Evacuations: Mandatory evacuations in place on Loma Vista, Shady Oak and Rock Ridge. Evacuations may be lifted at 6:00 PM this evening, if fire conditions continue to improve.

- The fire started on Thursday November 21, at 9:39PM
- 50 structures were threatened early in the incident
- Road closure at Soda Canyon and Loma Vista
- Fuels are brush and grassy oak woodland
- Winds are anticipated to decrease around 10:00PM this evening
- Continued building and holding fire containment lines
- Fire cause - under investigation
