Current Situation: The fire continues to burn in steep and rugged terrain which has caused access challenges for crews and fire equipment. Strong and erratic winds continue to cause dangerous fire behavior. Crews continue to construct and re-enforce containment lines.

Evacuation Orders: 278 Calpine employees were initially evacuated from the Calpine Geothermal Power Plant for their safety. As it becomes safe the employees are being allowed to return to the compound to facilitate the needs of the power plant.

Road Closures in effect for the general public: Cloverdale–Geysers Rd cross of Squaw Creek Rd. and Healdsburg-Geyser Rd. at Mercuryville. Closure is for general public, residents within the affected area are being allowed into their homes.
