Incident Summary: No smoke or glows reported last night. The fire is 632 acres and at 90% containment. Containment lines were wind tested for 4 hours yesterday and held.

Crews are continuing to mop-up, reinforce containment lines, check for hot spots and patrol the fire. Weather today is predicted to be much like yesterday only slightly cooler. A shift in the weather pattern is predicted for tomorrow through the weekend. An onshore flow will return to the area resulting in a noticeable cooling trend and an increase in humidity.

Resources are being demobilized and being made available for local Santa Barbara County Operational Area response as well as reassignment to other fires.

The cause of the fire remains under investigation.
