Firefighters are continuing to construct new containment lines and improve existing containment lines on the Cocos fire. Firefighters are also mopping up within the Cocos fire perimeter. Damage inspection teams are continuing to work on assessing damage and destroyed homes effected by the Cocos fire. The Highway Fire is 100% contained. There will not be any more updates on the Highway fire.
